

Cornhole

Instruction card



Traditional

Purpose

Throw as many bags in the hole as possible with your team.

Required material

- 4 wooden boxes
- Bean bags

Starting position

2 x 2 wooden boxes are placed opposite each other with 5 meters in between, with the side having 1 hole facing up. Behind each box, a team takes its place (maximum 4 teams of 4 participants). Each team gets 4 bean bags.



Gameplay

- Decide which team gets to throw first.
- Each team takes turns throwing a bean bag from behind their own box to the other box.
- Once all the bean bags have been thrown, the ones that didn't end up in the hole can be collected.
- The first team that throws all the bean bags into the hole wins.

Rules of the game

- Only allowed to throw underhand
- Throw from behind your own box.
- Collect the bean bags once they have all been thrown.

Role of game leader

- Supervision of the game rules and safety.
- Adjustment of the gameplay / rules if too difficult/easy.

Adjustment of gameplay / rules of the game

- Easier: Move the boxes closer to each other.
- More difficult: Move the boxes farther apart.
- More difficult: Remove one of the two boxes and have the participants throw at the same box (from the same distance). This way, they can make it more challenging for each other.

Connect four

Purpose

Be the first to throw four in a row.

Required material

- 4 wooden boxes
- Bean bags



Starting position

2 x 2 wooden boxes are placed opposite each other with 5 meters in between, with the side having 16 holes facing up. Behind each box, a team takes its place (maximum 4 teams of 4 participants). Each team gets 8 bean bags from the same color.

Gameplay

- Decide which team gets to throw first.
- Each team takes turns throwing a bean bag from behind their own box to the other box.
- Once all the bean bags have been thrown, the ones that didn't end up in the hole or are double in the hole can be collected.
- The first team that throws four in a row wins.

Rules of the game

- Only allowed to throw underhand.
- Throw from behind your own box.
- Collect the bean bags once they have all been thrown.

Role of game leader

- Supervision of the game rules and safety.
- Adjustment of the gameplay / rules if too difficult/easy.

Adjustment of gameplay / rules of the game

- Easier: Move the boxes closer to each other
- More difficult: Move the boxes farther apart.
- More difficult: Remove one of the two boxes and have the participants throw at the same box (from the same distance). This way, they can make it more challenging for each other. If a bean bag is thrown into a hole where there is already a bean bag from the other team, the bean bags are swapped.
For Example: if a blue bean bag is thrown into a hole where there is already a red bean bag, the red bean bag is removed, and the blue bean bag stays.

Battleship

Purpose

Be the first to sink all the other team's ships

Required material

- 4 wooden boxes bakken
- Bean bags
- 12 wooden discs (ships)



Starting position

2 x 2 wooden boxes are placed opposite each other with 5 meters in between, with the side having 16 holes facing up. Behind each box, a team takes its place (maximum 4 teams of 4 participants). Each team gets 8 bean bags and 3 wooden discs.

Gameplay

- Each team places three discs in three different holes in their box, without the other team noticing.
- Decide which team gets to throw first.
- Each team takes turns throwing a bean bag from behind their own box to the other box.
- Once all the bean bags have been thrown, the bean bags are used by the other team.
- The first team that sinks the opponent's three ships wins.

Rules of the game

- Only allowed to throw underhand.
- Throw from behind your own box.
- Don't collect the bean bags, but swap them.

Role of game leader

- Supervision of the game rules and safety.
- Adjustment of the gameplay / rules if too difficult/easy.

Aanpassing spelverloop / spelregels

- More difficult: Move the boxes farther apart.
